


As stated by Academy of Ideas, the aim of the Killing of the Mind video is to explore the most dangerous of all psychic epidemics, the mass psychosis. A mass psychosis is an epidemic of madness, and it occurs when a large portion of a society loses touch with reality and descends into delusions. Such a phenomenon is not a thing of fiction. Two examples of mass psychoses are the American and European witch hunts 16th and 17th centuries and the rise of totalitarianism in the 20th century.

The video aims to answer questions surrounding mass psychosis: What is it? How does it start? Has it happened before? Are we experiencing one right now? And if so, how can the stages of a mass psychosis be reversed?

As fear is much at the root of what drives the individual to an alternate reality to accommodate that fear, in a similar manner so does the fear promulgated by totalitarianism drive the masses to a form of obedient psychosis to accommodate that fear. We end up isolated and obedient. As we become more obedient to the rulers, we increasingly give up our morality. This enables us to do unmentionable things to others who do not fall in line with the new order.



This has happened in the past, e.g., Marxism and Hitler, and appears to be happening today. Truth is what the elites say it is. There are no facts, only the idea promulgated by the elite class. We, the masses, are so ruled and become disposable. In past regimes we were killed; in today's pseudo-utopia regimes, we are cancelled, our careers destroyed, and our lives left desolate and void of meaning.



The elites at the head of the totalitarian regime bombard us with illogic over and over until it is accepted as the truth. The lie becomes accepted as the new truth. And so, we march to our own demise.
